Our History

As one of Medicine Hat's oldest established schools, Alexandra's original building was constructed in 1909 and named after Queen Alexandra. The cornerstone was laid by Alberta's first Premier, the Honourable A. C. Rutherford and the school was officially opened in 1910 by Prime Minister Wilfrid Laurier. In 1955 Alexandra changed from a High School to a Junior High, and to reflect our focus on the middle-level learner, was renamed Alexandra Middle School in 2008. Updating of school buildings included replacement of the original structure (1971), a multi-purpose room (1985), and major renovations (1998-1999, 2007).

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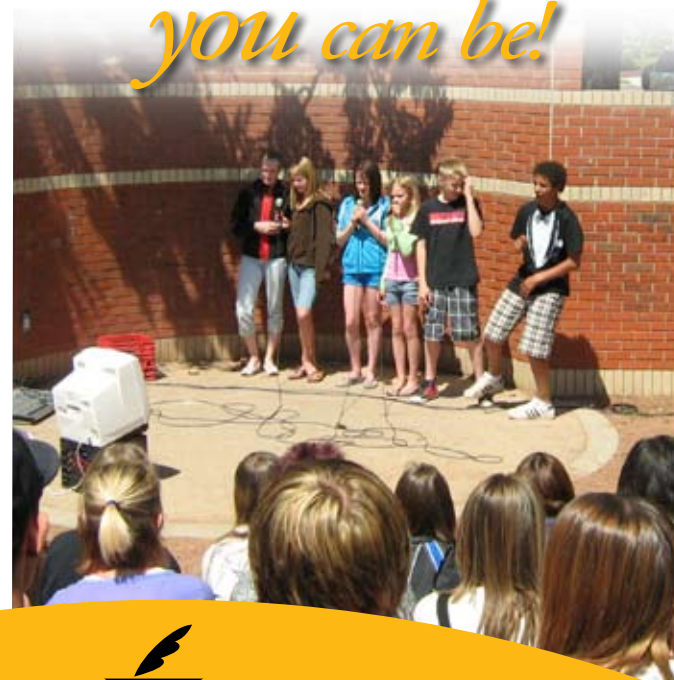
