

Sewing Club

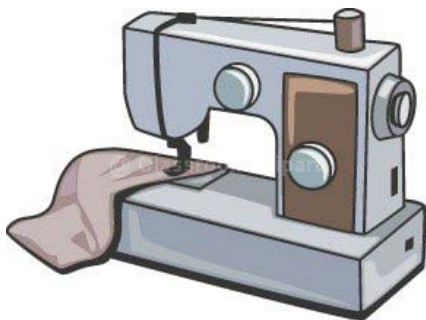
Alexandra Middle School is offering students a chance to learn how to sew. This club will run after school for 2 hours twice a week on Wednesday and Thursday. This club will operate from March 4 to the end of April. Students will get the opportunity to develop basic sewing skills.



Students will learn how to thread and operate a basic sewing machine. They will then create a bean bag frog and a pencil case.

Students will need to pay \$10.00 to cover the expenses for the first two projects. This will cover the cost of fabric for both projects, buttons, thread, needles, pins, bobbins and zippers. To fill the frog they will need to bring a bag of rice, popcorn or pearl barley.

Once they have this mastered, they will create a foot pillow. Students will need to provide their own material for the foot pillow. They will need to bring an old pillow case or purchase 1 meter of flannel, cotton or light fleece fabric, 1 spool of matching thread, 1 bobbin, and a bag of stuffing (**not** quilt batting).



There are only 15 sewing machines at the school. This opportunity will be offered to the first 15 paid students. If two students agree to share a machine, they will be accepted.
